All local lists and records should be sent to the Honorary Secretary not later than 31st December, 1949 if they are to be published in the 1950 Report. Please indicate clearly any which the recorder does not wish to be published.

WORK FOR 1949.

Many members have said that they would appreciate suggestions for work to be carried out in the present year. For all orders, local lists are required, if possible from every parish and including even the commonest species. Dates of first and last appearance are also valuable.

Birds. Any information about the following : Woodcock, Nightjar, Lesser White-throat, Hobby, Marsh Warbler, Wood Warbler, Stonechat, Whinchat, Redstart, Nuthatch, Hoodie Crow, Redwing, Brambling, Gulls, Pochard, Tufted Duck, Gadwall, Quail. Passage migration of Terns and Waders. Breeding of Gt. Crested Grebe and Heron. (Please communicate with Mr. Tebbutt immediately breeding is established). Census of rookeries (numbers of nests should be counted in first week of April).

Flora. The Victoria County History Vol. 1. (copy in the County Library) contains a list of plants not yet (in 1926) recorded for Hunts., but known to exist in adjacent counties. All these should be looked for and, if found, full details recorded. The list includes the following generally common plants: Slender St. John's Wort, Shining, Round-leaved and Long-stalked Cranesbills, Indian Balsam, Yellow Vetchling, Bird Cherry, Water Avens, Rowan, Golden Saxifrage, Woodruff, Red Valerian, Goldenrod, Ploughman's Spikenard, Sheepsbit, Clustered Bellflower, Yellow Mimulus, Common Cow-wheat, Spearmint, Horsemint, Wood Sage, Bay Willow, Wild Daffodil.

The following, which are included in the list, were found in 1948: Common Watercress, Prostrate Rest-Harrow, Snowberry, Winter Heliotrope, Prickly Lettuce, Wall Lettuce, Water Speedwell, Foxglove, Upright Goosefoot.

Butterflies and Moths. Precise localities of Marbled White, Essex Skipper and all Burnets. Woods in which Speckled Wood is absent. Distribution of Chequered Skipper, Dusky Sallow. Is the Grayling extinct? What is the local food-plant of the Brown Argus? Any sign of the Large Tortoiseshell, the Purple Emperor, the Wood White, the Small Pearl-bordered Fritillary?

Mammals. Any information about Deer, Badger, Polecat, Otter, Harvest Mouse, Dormouse, Red and Grey Squirrels and all species of Bat.

Nomenclature. The essential is unmistakable identification. For this scientific names are always best but not, in all orders, necessary. The reference book used (e.g. Handbook, Coward, Bentham and Hooker, Skene, South, Meyrick) should be quoted on all records.
